i3Detroit Celebrates 10th Anniversary With Open House March 24th

i3Detroit, a local makerspace, is 10 years old this year. It will be hosting an Open House on Sunday, March 24, 2019, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM at 1481A Wordsworth, Ferndale, Michigan 48220. The event is free to the public and will feature tours and demonstrations of woodworking, machining, welding, 3D printing, sewing, electronics, injection molding, leatherwork, ceramics and glasswork, laser cutting and robotics.

i3Detroit is a non-profit, membership-based, volunteer-run makerspace -- a place where artists, crafters, wood workers, machinists, hobbyists, "do-it-yourselfers", engineers and entrepreneurs can find the space, tools, equipment and community support to create the projects they've always dreamed about. Launched in 2009, the 7,200 square foot facility (expanding to nearly twice its size this year!) is home to a complete machine shop including a Bridgeport mill and an Acer lathe, a Haas CNC mill, a complete woodworking shop with a wood lathe, CNC router and SawStop table saw, injection molding equipment, kilns for ceramics and glasswork, a welding shop, 3D printers for real-time fabrication, a wide format printer, CNC vinyl cutter, two 150 watt laser cutter/engravers, a jewelry making area, a sewing and fabric arts area, and a fully equipped electronics lab. Members enjoy free training on the facility's equipment and 24/7 access. i3Detroit is a DIY dream – with all the tools and equipment you can only wish you could fit in your garage!
